There is a shortage of trained professionals and carers in Germany: hospitals and other medical establishments urgently require a way of utilising vacant training capacity and stabilising general medical care.

But young doctors in other European countries face a different problem: they cannot continue their training and qualify themselves in a way that is conducive to a promising career.

- Online platform with dual direct entry and structure (doctors/hospitals) and clear, simple user interface.
